Primary Years Programme

(PYP), for ages 3 - 12

Middle Years Programme

(MYP), for ages 11 - 16

Provides a framework of academic challenge that encourages students to embrace and understand the connections between traditional subjects and the real world and become critical and reflective thinkers who take action through service.

Diploma Programme

(DP), for ages 16 - 19
